

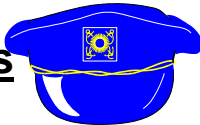

We are off to a great start - see you at the club!

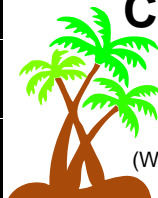

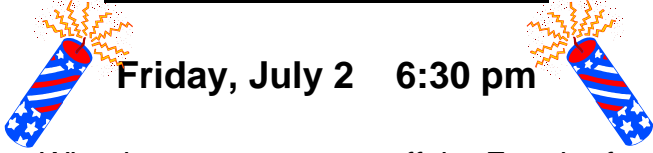

What better way to start off the Fourth of July weekend than with a cook-out with CLYC friends! Chicken will be available to cook on the grill - for only a \$3 charge.

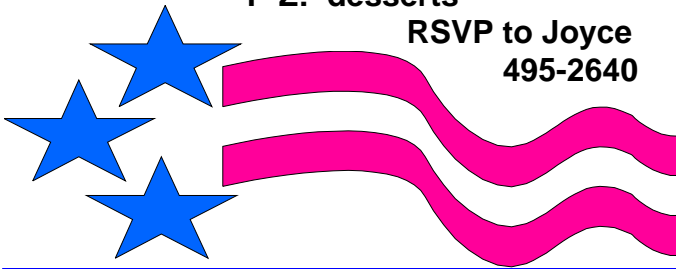

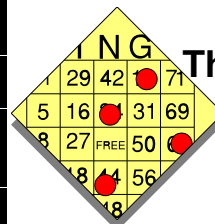
Your ship will leave port at 6 pm on Saturday, July 17th, destinations unknown. The bursar's fees are \$15 per person, payable on the pier.

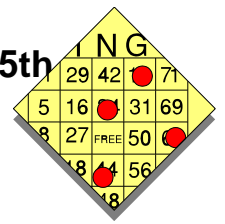

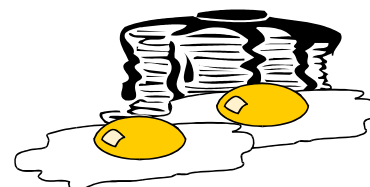

Catered Dinner

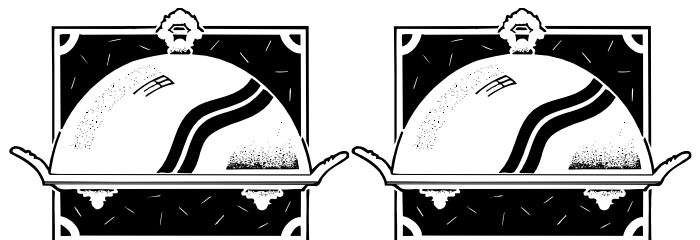
Due to the huge success of our first catered dinner, we've decided to do it again. We're still working on the details, so watch for information at the club. It's sure to be fun.

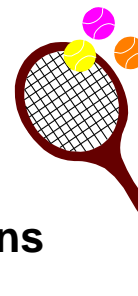
Tennis

Convenient "temporary memberships" are available to non-members for \$50 per week. Call Kate for details.

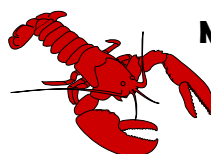

Youth Tennis Lessons

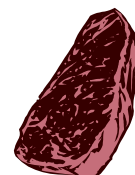

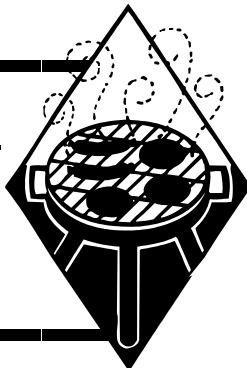

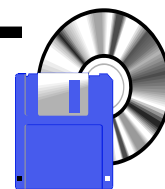
