The condition of the Clear Lake Public Beach is deplorable and Kimberly Wenger is doing something about it. For her Girl Scout Gold Award, she is organizing a massive clean up and restoration of the beach area.

Community support for the project has been phenomenal. Fremont Lumber is donating lumber to replace missing handrails and picnic table boards. Hanson Aggregates is donating sand to replenish the eroding bank and Merritt Trucking is donating the Slinger Truck to get sand to the beach. Van Gordon Construction will create a new concrete platform, with a step, at the base of the stairs. Fremont Hardware donated paint for the graffiti covered picnic tables. The Steuben County Park Department is assisting in the project.

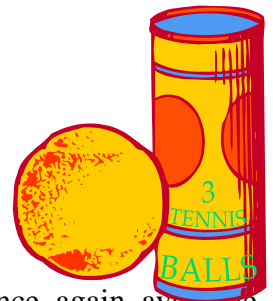
Tennis

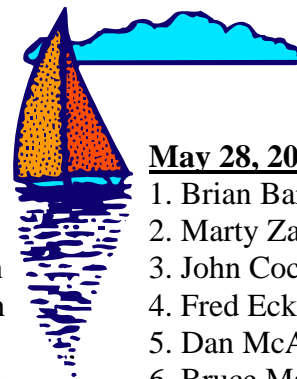
Ages range from adult (I won't reveal Kathy's age) to 7 years old. Gage has quite a bit of sailing experience but the rest of the group is just learning to sail.
