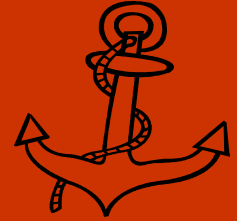

Parking Proposal

The Clear Lake Yacht Club (CLYC) Board of Directors has recommended the following agreement with the Clinrud Corp. It has not yet been fully ratified by either the Club or the Corporation. We are repeating the recommended provisions so everyone will be kept abreast.

1. CLYC members have access to the land for parking purposes only.

2. Sign a 10 year lease for parking access at a cost of \$1 per year.

3. In exchange for 1 & 2 we will do the following:

a.) Name the Clinrud corp. as an additionally insured

b.) Mow the property and pick up the trash during the summer months (Memorial Day through Labor Day)

c.) Place signage that the property is

to be used for CLYC member parking only and not for beach access

d.) Place fencing (chain link) at CLYC's expense along the front (with entrance gate for boat storage) and side of the property

e.) Evaluate (after the road is elevated) excavation and graveling of the parking area by Brooks construction. Any addition of stone and or gravel would be upon mutual consent of both parties. This would depend on drainage of the parking area after the road is elevated and the wetness/drainage of the parking area.



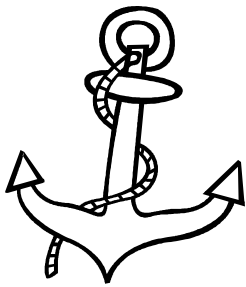
